Looking Back at 2013

I thought it was a good thing to look back at some of the things we have learned and accomplished in 2013. It is amazing this starts the 3rd year of the Bell's Messenger.

We started out the year with our Annual Meals after church by a group and our annual Bowling Trip to High Point Bowling Center.

In January, Keith Auman made an announcement that due to continued health issues he will not be able to return to Old Union and Fairview in July as once hoped. At that time the Pastor Parish Relations Committee had a meeting with the District Superintendent to find a new pastor. We had another successful Country Breakfast. We also had our annual Easter Egg Hunt, Easter Sunrise Service and Breakfast.

In April, we got word that the first time in recent Old Union History we would not be on a charge with another church and would not be sharing a preacher. Also we learned our new pastor in July would be the Rev. Jake

Brady and Rev. Nancy Krall would retire and be Fairview's pastor part time.

In May was the annual Relay for Life in Asheboro. Also it was decided that in July we would start having Sunday School at 10 am and Worship Service at 11 am. We lost another member of the church Ron Byrd. We also had another successful Country Breakfast.

In June we celebrated our Graduates giving them a Bible and then a Covered Dish Meal afterwards.

In July we had our Vacation Bible School which the theme was "Let's Build an Ark." That weekend we had 33 kids. We also welcomed a new Pastor, Rev. Jake Brady.

In August we had the Annual Back to School Party for the community.

In September we had our 227th Homecoming and Rev. Jake Brady was our speaker. We also had another successful Country Breakfast.

In October we had our annual Halloween Party were we had at least 100 visitors.

In November the United Methodist Women had the 10th Annual Country Buffet and Live Auction. The United Methodist Men had their annual Pork Shoulder sale right before Thanksgiving.

In December the Youth Ministry went Christmas Caroling and we had 19 people go out caroling. Each of the groups and Sunday School classes had their Christmas parties. We welcomed a new baby to the congregation, Cullen Lane Frazier. And then we had our annual Christmas Program which was "Christmas in Black and White" and was by the Youth Ministry and we also had our

Barbecue Meal after the program and we estimated around 150 attended it.

So as you can see we were blessed over the past year. I know there are some things I have missed but these are some of the highlights.

We should also be thankful that we are blessed by so many individuals who serve our church without a salary.

I read in the paper last week there is a United Methodist Church in Lexington that their last day open was Sunday, December 29th. We all need to continue to think of ways we can grow Old Union because we don't want to end up like that church. Let's make 2014 an even more blessed year.
